Patient/Population/Problem/Program

Patient Characteristics

(Primary problem, disease, or co-existing conditions – consider sex, age, or race of a patient, if relevant)



Intervention, prognosis or exposure

Main intervention, prognostic factor, or exposure being considered.



Comparison intervention

Main alternative being considered to compare with the intervention. (placebo, standard therapy, no treatment, gold standard).

Your clinical question does not always need a comparison.



Outcome

What you hope to accomplish, measure, improve, or affect.

PICO

In low-birth-weight/pre-term neonates in health facilities, is skin to skin contact immediately after birth more effective than conventional care in preventing hypothermia?

Background

- Female athlete triad is a medical condition in physically active females consisting of 3 components: low energy availability with or without disordered eating, menstrual dysfunction, and low bone density, each occurring on a spectrum.
- Risk factors for female athlete triad include participation in sports with endurance, aesthetic, or weight-class components or sports that emphasize and reward leanness.

Evaluation

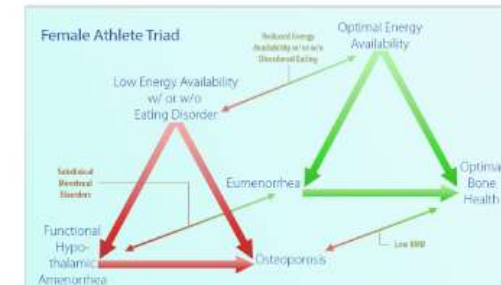
- Screen all active females for components of the triad at their sports participation examination or annual health screening examination (ACSM Grade C-2).
- The diagnosis of female athlete triad is based on history and physical examination findings usually found during the screening for a sports preparticipation examination or an annual health examination.

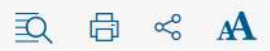

INTRODUCTION

Neuraxial analgesia and anesthesia (ie, spinal, epidural, and combined spinal epidural) for labor and delivery are generally very safe, but all interventions are associated with adverse effects. The practice of obstetric anesthesia has evolved in large part to minimize such adverse effects. This topic will review the side effects and complications of neuraxial anesthetic techniques used for labor and delivery.

Serious neurologic complications of neuraxial anesthesia (eg, meningitis, spinal epidural abscess, arachnoiditis, spinal cord injury) are discussed separately. (See "Serious neurologic complications of neuraxial anesthesia procedures in obstetric patients".)
