This is why the brachial plexus is so frequently the anesthesiologist's favorite group of nerves.

The late David Little's appropriate observations do not always lead anesthesiologists to choose a regional anesthetic for upper extremity surgery. However, those selecting regional anesthesia recognize that there are multiple sites at which the brachial plexus block can be induced. If anesthesiologists are to deliver comprehensive anesthesia care, they should be familiar with brachial plexus blocks. Familiarity with these techniques demands an understanding of brachial plexus anatomy. One problem with understanding this anatomy is that the traditional wiring diagram for the brachial plexus is unnecessarily complex and intimidating.

- 1 The rate of anesthetic complications will never be zero. All anesthesia practitioners, irrespective of their experience, abilities, diligence, and best intentions, will participate in anesthetics that are associated with patient injury.
- 2 Malpractice occurs when four requirements have been met: (1) the practitioner must have a duty to the patient; (2) there must have been a breach of duty (deviation from the standard of care); (3) the patient (plaintiff) must have suffered an injury; and (4) the proximate cause of the injury must have been the practitioner's deviation from the standard of care.
- 3 Anesthetic mishaps can be categorized as preventable or unpreventable. Of the preventable incidents, most involve human error, as opposed to equipment malfunctions.

Synopsis

Medications are a common cause of hypotension, particularly in the elderly. Medications most commonly cause [orthostatic hypotension](#). In severe cases, drug-induced orthostatic hypotension can lead to syncope, falls, or ischemia to vital organs. Rapid changes in medications or new illnesses may exacerbate drug-induced orthostatic hypotension. Many drugs are implicated in orthostatic hypotension, but some of the more common ones include calcium channel blockers, beta blockers, diuretics, vasodilators, dopaminergic drugs, and antipsychotics. Discontinuing the offending drug usually resolves the hypotension.
